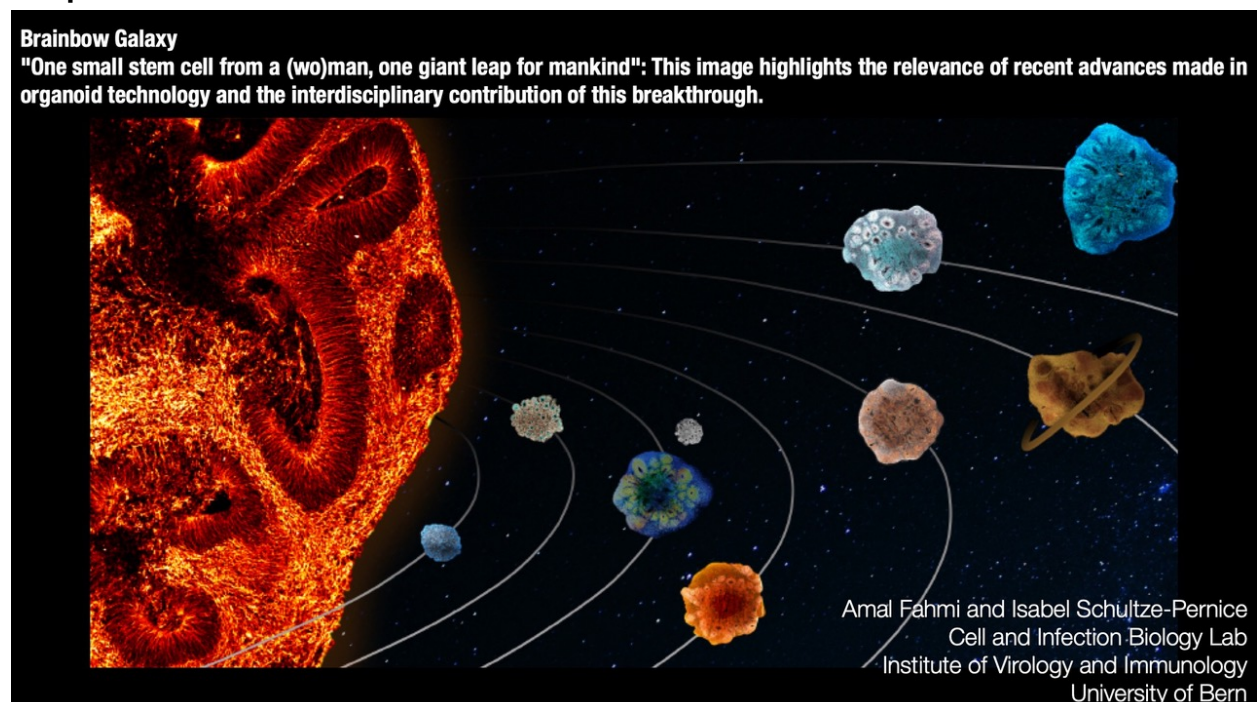

TOR-DBMR Symposium, May 31 2023

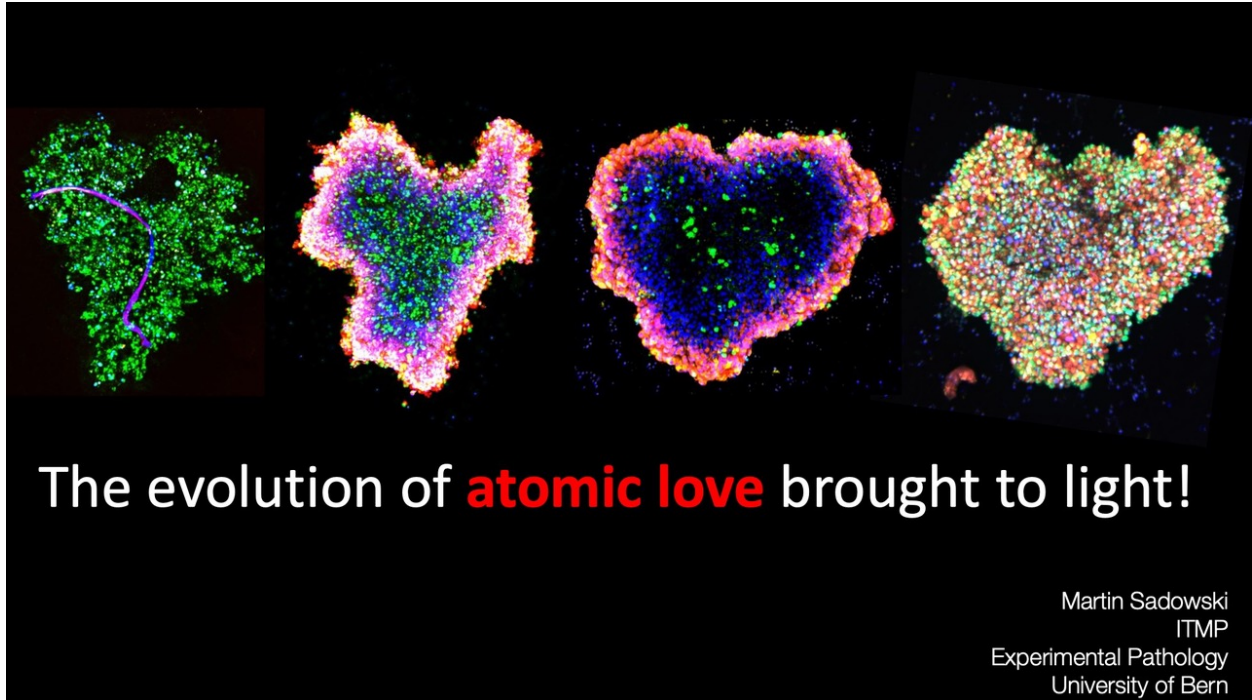
